Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry to approve the Consent Agenda and Minutes as presented from January 17, 2023, and the Accounts Payable. Motion carried on vote: Ayes: 2, Nays: 0

Updates were given and all libraries have had increases in patrons both young and old. They have also become more diversified in the small communities and adding programs which are welcoming to all.
