Updates were provided on the Levi Road speed analysis, Level B road maintenance and private rock placement, and tree clearing on Hilman Road pending confirmation of State ownership and any DOT agreements; Crouch & Ferro discussed Surface Transportation Block Grant that MAPA administers and use of a point system to approve applications.
