Resolution 25-35 Appropriating Funds from Budget Amendment #2

BE IT REMEMBERED on this 13th day of November 2025, the Mills County Board of Supervisors met in session for the purpose of amending the current operating budget. There was present a quorum as required by law. Thereupon the Supervisors found that the notice of time and place of hearing has, according to law, been published in County papers, and that the affidavits of publication thereof were on file with the County Auditor. Thereafter, and on said date, the amendment was taken up and considered and taxpayers heard for or against the amendment as follows:
